

The Bert Allwood Alexandra Palace Organ Scholarship

The trustees of the Alexandra Palace Organ Appeal wish to appoint an Organ Scholar with effect from 1st October 2019. The scholarship will be tenable for a period of 1 year.

The Scholarship

In addition to practice privileges on the Willis Grand Organ, the successful candidate will receive free organ tuition with a Royal College of Organists Accredited Teacher, and further guidance under the RCO's mentorship scheme. Other practice venues can be arranged when the Great Hall is unavailable.

The scholarship attracts a stipend of £500 per annum, which could be used towards the purchase of music, or other materials related to further study. The Organ Scholar would help to maintain the area around the organ, and will also be required to assist at concerts. At present, these occur 4-5 times a year. Other performance opportunities may be available to the successful candidate, for which extra fees would be payable.

It is hoped that the successful candidate will have an excellent sense of self-motivation, and a firm commitment to developing his/her skills as an organist. As a representative of the Alexandra Palace Organ Appeal, good communication skills are essential. This post would suit a gap year student, although other enquiries are very welcome.
