

New organ at Reed

Church Close, Reed, Royston, SG8 8AP



The organ is a new 2-manual instrument built by Mander Organ Builders, combining the pipework from the previous Reed organ, with that which was originally built for the Wesley Hall, Sheffield. Mechanical key action, electric stop action, detached console, 18 stops.
